Re: Illinois Regional Site Readiness Program Grant - DCEO

The City will be receiving an Illinois DCEO Regional Site Readiness Program Grant in the amount of \$2,974,912.00 for the construction of the extension of Gateway Center Drive east of Farmington Way, water and sanitary sewer main extensions and sanitary sewer lift station to serve 137.92 acres of undeveloped property as shown on the attached map. The total estimated cost of this project is \$3,718,640.00. The local share is \$743,728.00. The property will be subdivided in conjunction with this project and the local share will either be paid for by the developer or the lots created will be subject to a recapture ordinance for the local share of the project cost.

I would recommend a motion to accept the Illinois DCEO Regional Site Readiness Program Grant in the sum of \$2,974,912.00 and authorize the Mayor or his designee to execute all documents necessary to receive the grant including, but not limited to, the grant agreement.

Attached to this memo is a proposal from CES, Inc to complete the final design engineering and bidding documents for the Site Readiness Grant public improvements in the amount of \$190,300.00.

I would recommend approval of the proposal from CES, Inc. to complete the design engineering and bidding documents for the Regional Site Readiness Grant Project, in the amount of \$190,300.00, contingent on receipt of a fully-executed Grant Agreement with the Illinois DCEO. This work will be paid for from Capital Funds.

General scope of work to be completed:

C.E.S. Inc. will prepare Construction Plans, Specifications and Bid Documents for the proposed infrastructure (road, sanitary sewer, watermain, forcemain and lift station) as illustrated on the included Exhibit.
